**1. Reason for the Report:**

1.1 To report on the procedure for appointments to the Council's Committees.

**2. Recommendation**

2.1 That Council notes the nominees of the political groups to Committees.

**3. Background and Detail**

3.1 Having decided what committees there should be, their size and political composition, the nominees of the political groups are automatically appointed by the Monitoring Officer. The Council may only appoint to a Committee those members who do not form part of a political group. **The nominees of the political groups will be circulated.**

3.2 The Local Government Act 2000 and subsequent regulations, prescribe that, under executive arrangements, joint committees exercising executive functions are appointed by the Executive rather than Council.

3.3 These appointments will, therefore, be made at the first meeting of the Executive.
