Saving requirement plus indicative profile of thematic savings potential

Early realisation of savings is beneficial – Plan allows for limited slippage

AES – Efficiency Programme 24/25

- Reduction of Pavement Sweepers from 4 to 3 in both Council area – Target £23k

Page 7 Introduction of Organic waste collections in High Peak
– Target £5k

- Total - £28k

Progress to date April - Aug

- Procurement of sweepers
 - Completed but delayed from July to August
 - Some efficiencies achieved but at reduced level months savings (sept – march)
 - Currently calculating pro rata savings
- Introduction of Organic waste collections
 - Gaining traction and converting into sales challenging
 - Continued marketing effort underway

Next Steps

- Continue to work with AES to deliver 24/25 efficiency targets and Identify potential new opportunities
- Continue to update and engage AES Commissioning Board in Efficiency Programme targets/progress
- **Develop opportunities for increased income with Alliance Norse, particularly in commercial trading**
- Provide progress updates to this Committee where required
- Forward planning for 25/26
 - Bulky waste collection income
 - Organic waste collection income
 - Ongoing sweeper savings
