Following the challenge regarding the application of a outside bar licence for The Roebuck PH, Cheadle Road, Forsbrook on the grounds of noise pollution. As a local resident and user of the public house I know the landlord Paul who is also part of our local community. He fully understands his responsibility and commitment to the local community regarding noise pollution. Over the last few years in which I have been using the pub no live entertainment has taken place outside the pub after 21:00hrs. Knowing this has been the case for the last 3 years and the introduction of an external bar would not change this, given you could walk 10 metres to the internal bar get a drink and return outside if you wanted to. So the challenge regarding an increase in noise pollution due to the introduction of an external bar isn't valid. The noise level and adherence to local environmental requirements is controlled by having a conscientious landlord who wants to provide a local pub for local people without affecting the lives of local community who choose not to use the public house.
