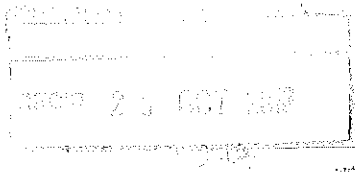

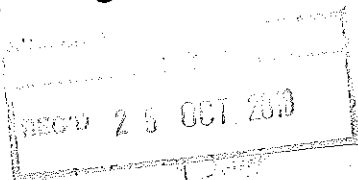

To Protect Children From Harm

Sheep Market has a massive problem with large groups of underage youths drinking and trying to gain entry to the public houses. The area is already not a suitable environment for them but with the possibility and temptation of locally accessible alcohol it could become a magnet.

Sheep Market is a family friendly shopping environment in the day with lots of small children but we do have a lot of local public houses with the mix of them and an off licence meaning alcohol will be accessible for at least 19 hours a day. This could have a very negative effect attracting people children should not have to be exposed to.

To Prevent Public Nuisance

Drinkers are regularly sick and urinate in door ways in Sheep market. Access to alcohol at a cheaper cost than the pubs for 19 hours could accelerate the problem with abusers drinking in the streets at all times of the day and night.

The Sheep Market is already full of drunks due to a take-away being open until 3am. At times you can have up to 70+ drunks at night with the extra attraction of more alcohol when the Pubs are closed or the alcohol just being cheaper things can get out of hand. There is already a massive problem with drinking in the Sheep market at night easily accessible alcohol will just add to the problem.

Extra vehicles at night to what is a pedestrianised street would become even more of a public nuisance.

Vehicles are already parked on the pavements with many more picking up takeaways.

We are promoting Leek as a tourist town an off licence could attract the wrong people into town at all sorts of hours, both day and night. This would be very damaging to the Local Plan and Local economy.

To Prevent Crime and Disorder

Sheep Market already has regular alcohol related fights on Fridays and Saturdays due to the location of eight Public houses all less than two minutes away, with the addition of cheaper alcohol for 19 hours a day from such a local site alcohol abusers will find it too convenient when moving from pub to pub or for drinking in the street.

Windows are often smashed in the Sheep market due to the high concentration of drunk people at night. In the last 12 months five windows have been smashed, 2 of them being at 15 Sheep Market.

The location of an off licence so close to public houses with beer gardens will encourage the purchase of unmanaged levels of alcohol being taken to these locations for consumption. This will then at some point spill into the area adding to an already massive antisocial problem.

Sheep Market already has a massive problem with antisocial drinking if the service of alcohol is extended to 19 hours a day it can only attract drunks, disorder and possible crime.

I Jason Smith of 11A Sheep Market live and work next door to 15 Sheep Market and have witnessed the very negative effect alcohol abuse has had on the area.

I regularly have sick and urine in my doorway as do my neighbours.

I am woken up in the early hours every weekend at some point to shouting and fighting.

I have to call the police at least three times a month to alcohol related incidents.

I have had to take steps to protect my self and my business as my insurance will not pay out anymore. External Gills and external CCTV have been fitted at a cost of £3550.00 due to the alcohol related crime in the area.

In my opinion with the experience of twelve years living and working in the area an off licence with such long opening hours would have a very negative effect purely because of its location in the middle of a drinkers area which already has major alcohol related problems.

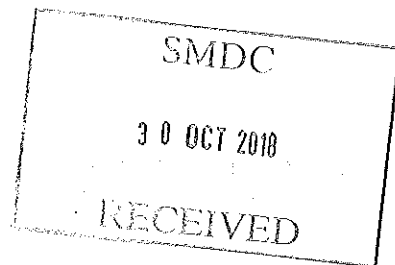
