T36	Common Yew	Crown lift to remove lower secondary branches and pendulous growth to approx. 3 – 4m above ground level	To provide clearance over headstones and churchyard gate, and to maintain access for grasscutting
T38	Irish Yew	Crown lift to remove lower secondary branches and pendulous growth to approx. 3 – 4m above ground level	To provide clearance over headstones, and to maintain access for grasscutting
T39	Irish Yew	Crown lift to remove lower secondary branches and pendulous growth to approx. 3 – 4m above ground level	To provide clearance over headstones, and to maintain access for grasscutting
T40	Common Yew	Crown lift to remove lower secondary branches and pendulous growth to approx. 3 – 4m above ground level; crown reduction to shorten projecting elongated lateral branches back by 2 – 4m into the main crown	To provide clearance over pavement and churchyard gate, to maintain access for grasscutting, and to improve the overall crown shape
T42	Red Horse Chestnut	Lateral reduction of upper and lower crown by approx. 2m on eastern side	To increase clearance from gable of church and east window
T43	Irish Yew	Crown reduction by approx. 40 – 50% (height and spread)	To open up the view of/from the main church door and make the church more welcoming, and to address encroachment over the paths
T45	Irish Yew	Crown reduction by approx. 40 – 50% (height and spread)	To open up the view of/from the main church door and make the church more welcoming, and to address encroachment over the paths
T46	Red Horse Chestnut	Crown lift to remove basal shoots, lower secondary branches and pendulous growth to approx. 3 – 4m above ground level	To provide clearance over headstones, and to maintain access for grasscutting
