Dear Mr Snelling,

Mr Snelling, as the CCTV has not been provided as requested in previous emails and hand delivered correspondence. I now make a further request that the CCTV is produced to Staffordshire police within seven days from delivery of this email. I have made every effort to facilitate the supply of the footage without success. Please provide the requested CCTV footage by the 18th January 2021 which is an additional seven days from the original date for compliance which was the 11th January 2021.

In any event that you do not provide the CCTV footage requested within the seven days it will be deemed that you have failed to comply with legislation as defined under the Licensing Act 2003 and an application will be made to review the premises licence before the licensing subcommittee of the issuing Local Authority.

The CCTV footage requested is as follows.
