

## **Notice of Motion**

The Statutory Taxi and Private Hire Vehicle Standards 2020 recommend that licensing authorities keep under review any local justification for the introduction of CCTV in Taxi and Private Hire Vehicles. This Council's 2016 policy contains, in Appendix L, the provision for the Council to introduce CCTV as a requirement.

The Police and Crime Commissioner for Derbyshire has called upon all Derbyshire Councils to make camera installation a condition of licensing in order to better protect women and the vulnerable. An increasing number of councils, regardless of political persuasion, have mandated that all taxis and private hire vehicles they license be fitted with CCTV cameras.

This Council resolves to carry out a consultation with residents and stakeholders on the use of CCTV in licensed Taxis and Private Hire Vehicles between 1st March and 31st May 2022; the results of the consultation to be considered by Council in September/October 2022.
