

Appendix 4 UK Shared Prosperity Fund Proposals – High Peak

Following the webinar held on 14th July a considerable number of ideas and proposals were received and some suggestions regarding the interventions.

Overall the consultees were content with all the interventions proposed which have attracted a number of proposals especially for E7, Support for active travel enhancements in the local area. E8 and E17 tourism initiatives with a focus on sustainable and accessible tourism, E11 Investment in capacity building and infrastructure support for local civil society, E13 Community measures to reduce the cost of living including measures to improve energy efficiency, combat fuel poverty and climate change, E39 Green skills, E24 incubators and E26 social enterprises. Most suggested ideas would fit into those however some suggested adding the below: -

E3 Creation of and improvements to local green spaces, community gardens, watercourses and embankments, along with incorporating natural features into wider public spaces.

E6 Support for local arts, cultural, heritage and creative activities.

E29 Supporting decarbonisation and improving the natural environment whilst growing the local economy.

E33 Employment support for economically inactive people

There was a strong green and cultural/arts response to the consultation arising from the social enterprise sector and local community organisations. Accessibility improvements within town centres and tourism facilities were frequently mentioned.

Within High Peak there is a strong community base which desires to consolidate and a good deal of support was gathered for the proposal to create a co-ordinating Cultural Consortium

The other predominant theme was to support the transition to a green economy incorporating all themes including community energy, transport, tourism and skills.
