

### **SUB-COMMITTEES / WORKING GROUPS**

**Asset Management Working Group** (Councillors Payne, Grooby, Clarke, Collins, Hall, Siddall)

Established by Corporate Select Committee to monitor progress and make recommendations on the implementation of the Asset Management Framework linked to the Corporate priorities and aims of the Council. This Working Group had its first meeting in January 2024 and its work is on-going. The Group is chaired by Councillor Payne.

**Joint Leisure Operations Working Group** (Councillors Quinn, Benzer, Elliott-Starkey, Evans, Grooby, Inman and Payne)

Established jointly with Staffordshire Moorlands District Council by Community Select Committee to consider the outcome of the Sports England assessment; scrutinise the proposed management options and to have oversight of the implementation of the LATCo. Joint Chairs have been appointed with Councillor Quinn being the Chair on behalf of HPBC. The Group had its first meeting in November 2023 and its work is on-going.

**Housing Board** (Councillors Barrow, A McKeown, Sloman, De Pee, J Taylor, Grooby, Sizeland plus tenant representatives)

Established as a Standing Sub-Committee by Community Select Committee to provide oversight of the operation and management of the Council's housing stock; to review the Council's compliance with the legislative regulatory regime, including compliance with the Regulator of Housing's Standards; to scrutinise the performance against Key performance Indicators relating to the operation and management of the Council's housing stock; to scrutinise the development of the Council's HRA Strategy; to ensure that the views of tenants are considered by the Council in the operation and management of their housing stock; to ensure the engagement of Ward Councillors with significant housing stock within their wards and to make recommendations as appropriate to the Select Committees and the Executive.

**Clear, Hold, Build Working Group** (Membership to be agreed)

Established by Community Select Committee to steer the CHB project in partnership with other agencies including the police and education providers.
